Tenda, is an ecologically-empathetic habitat conceived by SCDA Lab that aims to generate measurable, beneficial social and environmental impact to their immediate context. The relocatable dwellings are Net Zero and generate and collect their own energy and water; representing an optimism towards sustainability. Part of the Income generated through Tenda allows the ecologically empathetic traveler to live in harmony with nature and contribute back to the community.
